

- Uniform self mulching clay soils very efficient for furrow irrigation
- Completely protected from flooding with flood free access to sealed roads (50km)
- Largest area of permanent sub surface drip irrigation in Australia (and expanding)
- The only on farm cotton gin in Australia with both saw and roller gins

Tandou Farm - Unique Advantages

- Low pest incidence isolated from other grain and cotton producing areas
- Low cost gravity irrigation (mostly)
- Licensed on farm 160,000ML water storage for off-allocation flows
- Ability to vary area planted and crop mix to meet market demand and water availability
